

# **Computer Training**

To provide Computer Training at affordable cost, 1000 Youth Computer Training Centres are operating in the state which have been set up in joint venture between Department of Youth Services and Sports and various Computer Training Service providers.

Course duration, curriculum and course fees at all these Centres are uniform. The course fees are much lesser than private training centres.

Interested candidates are requested to contact their nearest Youth Computer Training Centre. Information can also be obtained from Department of Youth Services and Sports, District Youth offices or nearest Block/Municipal Youth Offices.

All Youth Computer Training Centres have come under the purview of Online Examination System. The World famous organisation Hewlett Packard Enterprise India Pvt. Ltd. has been entrusted upon to conduct the entire system of online examination and evaluation thereof. Introduction of this system maintains parity in case of evaluation of the syllabus of all Youth Computer Training Centres and it also enables the students to get their Certificates online within a short interval from the date of completion of their examination.

CITA, CFAS, CDTP, CWD, CCST, CCHM, CCAD & CBM Courses are conducted Six months duration. DITA, DFAS, DDTP, DCHM, DMAVE, BPO courses are conducted with One year duration. ADITA, ADFAS & ADDTP courses are taught in One year & Six months duration.
